The Westlake Fire Department is now accepting applications for firefighters. The department is planning a hiring process to hire for immediate openings and establish a hiring list. The Westlake Fire Department has a 48-hour on-duty and 96-hour off-duty shift schedule.

The following are the minimum requirements for firefighters. All candidates must meet all minimum requirements <u>at the time of the job offer:</u>

- Must be at least 18 years of age.
- Able to work in the United States.
- Must have a valid Social Security Card.
- Must be able to read, write, and speak English.
- Have a current Driver's License and Motor Vehicle insurance.
- Have a High School Diploma, GED Certificate, or College transcripts.
- Certified by the Texas Commission on Fire Protection as a Basic Firefighter.
- Certified as an EMT-B with the Texas Department of State Health Services.
- Pass a Medical Physical in accordance with NFPA 1582
- Submit and Pass a Background Check

A written exam will be held on November 15, 2024, and November 16, 2024. The written test will be the Fire Aptitude and Character Test (FACT). A FACT Candidate Orientation Guide is available from the Fire and Police Selection, Inc. for an extra cost, but is not required.

Candidates will be contacted by e-mail or phone to confirm they are eligible for testing. Please check our website for the latest update on testing information.

## To be eligible for the Physical Ability Test all candidates must pass the written exam.
